



ICPR 2026 Call For Workshops

The ICPR 2026 Workshop Chairs invite workshop proposals for the **28th International Conference on Pattern Recognition** (<https://icpr2026.org/>). The main conference is to be held in Lyon, France during August 17-20, 2026, with workshops following on August 21-22. Workshops can be half-day or full-day, and workshops will take place physically. We seek Workshop proposals on timely topics on Pattern Recognition, Computer Vision, Image and Video Analysis, Biometrics, Document Analysis and Recognition, Biomedical Imaging and Bioinformatics, Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, Human Computer Interaction, etc. Workshops are expected to provide a forum for the active exchange of ideas and experiences on a specific topic or application. Members from all segments of the ICPR community are invited to submit workshop proposals for review. Each proposal will be assessed based on its scientific merit, proposed structure, overall relevance, and how it complements the main conference.

Workshop organizers will be responsible for inviting speakers and ensuring their participation, submission, and review of papers, preparation of the program, while local arrangements, including lunch, tea and coffee, will be arranged by the ICPR main organizer.

The registration fee for workshop participation will be set by ICPR 2026 and will be the same for all workshops. ICPR 2026 main organizers reserves the right to cancel any workshop if there are too few registrations for the workshop by the early registration deadline to cover the costs of hosting the workshop. ICPR 2026 may offer accepted workshops support for travel, accommodation and workshop registration, up to a fixed amount, for one keynote/invited speaker.

Guideline for Submitting Proposals.

Workshop proposals must be submitted via the ICPR workshop application form at: <https://iapr.org/conferences/international-conference-on-pattern-recognition/icpr-workshop-application-form/> A copy of the proposal should also be sent to icpr2026workshops@gmail.com.

All workshops must be endorsed or approved by the IAPR Conferences and Meetings Committee (via the application form). Peer-reviewed papers of approved workshops can be published in Lecture Notes in Computer Science (LNCS), Springer. However, a workshop organizer may publish their proceeding in a different avenue. ICPR workshops are not required to pay any levy to IAPR.

The proposals should include the following information.

1. TOPIC, RELEVANCE AND DESCRIPTION

- The topics covered by the workshop, with a description which specify the goals and the technical issues that the workshop aims to address.

- A brief discussion of why and the workshop is relevant and of interest for the community.
- A description of how the proposal relates to previous workshops at main conferences in the field.

2. ORGANIZERS AND SPEAKERS INFORMATION

- The names, affiliations, and email addresses of the workshop organizers.
- Why the proposers are well suited for organizing the workshop (including past experience).
- Invited Speakers Names and Tentative Talk Titles. For each speaker, please indicate if attendance is tentative or confirmed.

3. LOGISTICS

- Preference for half-day or full-day workshop.
- Estimated numbers of oral presentations and posters.
- Tentative program outline.
- Expected number of paper submissions.
- Program committee list. For each committee member, please indicate if the inclusion in the list is tentative or confirmed.
- Expected number of attendees.
- Advertisement and publicity planned.

4. IMPORTANT DATES OF THE WORKSHOP

- Workshop paper submission deadline.
- Notification to authors.
- Camera ready deadline (not later than July 31, 2026)
